Tures söner spelade också fiol. Den som mest följt i faderns fotspår är Bill Hansson i Uddevalla, som spelade i Uddevalla spelmanslag och Uddevalla folkdanslag. Förutom de låtar fadern lärt honom har Bill tillfört bohusmusiken flera egna kompositioner. Inspiration kunde han få från såväl naturen som i umgänget med spelkamrater. Bill blev riksspelman 1974.
